Chair Set S-317

Illustrated on opposite page

MATERIALS:

J. & P. COATS "KNIT-CRO-SHEEN,"
Art. A.64: 14 balls of No. 68
Skipper Blue (for one chair).

Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 1.
A chair cushion.

Use thread double throughout.

GAUGE: 6 sc make 1 inch; 6 rows
make 1 inch.

SEAT COVER . . . Starting at one
end of chair cushion, make a chain
slightly longer than cushion. **1st row:**
Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch
across, until row measures same as
cushion. Cut off remaining chain. Ch 1,
turn. Hereafter pick up back loop of
each sc. **2nd row:** Sc in each sc across.
Ch 1, turn. Repeat 2nd row until piece
is long enough to reach around cushion.
Break off. Fold in half and sew
up side seams. Insert cushion and sew
up opening.

BACK PIECE . . . Starting at bot-
tom, make a chain slightly longer
than back of chair. Work as for Seat
Cover until piece measures 12 inches.
Break off. Fold in half and sew up
side seams.

Curtain Edging S-318

MATERIALS:

CLARK'S O.N.T. BEST SIX CORD MER-
CERIZED CROCHET, Art. B.4, Size
30: 6 balls of No. 76 China Blue, or

J. & P. COATS BEST SIX CORD MER-
CERIZED CROCHET, Art. A.104,
Size 30: 3 balls of a color of your
own choice, or

CLARK'S BIG BALL MERCERIZED
CROCHET, Art. B.34, Size 30: 3
balls of a color of your own choice.

Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 10.
6 yards of yellow plastic (or other
curtain) material, 36 inches wide.

CURTAIN . . . Cut $2\frac{1}{4}$ yards of
yellow material. Make a $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch hem
on one short end. Make a correspond-
ing hem on other short end on oppo-
site side of material. Fold material,
having one length 15 inches longer
than the other. Stitch across top about
2 inches from top fold.

EDGING . . . Starting at narrow end,
ch 6. **1st row:** In 6th ch from hook
make dc, ch 1 and dc (shell made).
Ch 5, turn. **2nd row:** In sp of shell
make dc, ch 1 and dc (shell over
shell); in loop of turning chain make
(ch 1, tr) 7 times. Ch 5, turn. **3rd
row:** Sc in first sp, (ch 3, sc in next
sp) 5 times; ch 3, shell over shell.
Ch 5, turn. **4th and 5th rows:** Shell
over shell. Ch 5, turn. Repeat 2nd to
5th rows incl until piece reaches across
width of curtain, ending with 3rd row.
Break off.

HEADING . . . Attach thread to first
free loop on straight edge, sc in same
place, * ch 6, sc in next loop. Repeat
from * across. Break off.

Make another piece the same way.
Sew Edgings to curtain, using hem
stitches as a guide. Make another cur-
tain the same way.

VALANCE . . . Cut remaining plastic
in half lengthwise. Sew narrow ends
together. Make a $2\frac{1}{2}$ -inch hem across
bottom and a 2-inch hem across top.

Make a piece of edging to reach
across valance. Sew in place.

Using matching colors, make the
same edging for kitchen towels.

Grape Doily S-319

MATERIALS:

J. & P. COATS "KNIT-CRO-SHEEN,"
Art. A.64: 1 ball each of White,
No. 48 Hunter's Green and No. 49
Chartreuse Green. 2 balls of No.
18-A Shaded Purples.

Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 7.

Doily measures 16 inches in diameter.

Starting at center with White, ch 8.
Join with sl st to form ring. **1st rnd:**
Ch 3, 15 dc in ring. Join. **2nd rnd:**

Ch 4, 2 tr in same place as sl st, 3 tr
in each dc around. Join. **3rd rnd:** Ch 4,
4 tr in same place as sl st, * skip 2 tr,
5 tr in next tr. Repeat from * around.
Join. **4th rnd:** Sl st in next 2 tr, ch 4,
3 tr in same place as last sl st, * skip
4 tr, 7 tr in next tr. Repeat from *
around, ending with 3 tr in same place
as first 3 tr were made. Join. **5th rnd:**
Ch 4, 3 tr in same place as sl st, 7 tr
in center tr of each tr group around,
ending with 3 tr in same place as first
3 tr were made. Join. **6th rnd:** Ch 4,
4 tr in same place as sl st, 9 tr in
center tr of each tr group around, end-
ing with 4 tr in same place as first
4 tr were made. Join. **7th rnd:** Ch 4,
5 tr in same place as sl st, 11 tr in
center tr of each tr group around, end-
ing with 5 tr in same place as first
5 tr were made. Join and break off.
8th rnd: Attach Chartreuse Green to
same place as sl st, ch 6, * in same
place make (tr, ch 2) 6 times and tr;
ch 5, skip 3 tr of next group, 5 tr in
next tr, ch 3, skip 3 tr, 5 tr in next tr,
ch 5, tr in center tr of next group,
ch 2. Repeat from * around. Join
and break off.

Now work bunches of grapes indi-
vidually as follows: **1st row:** Attach
Shaded Purples to first ch-2 sp of any
tr group, ch 4, 7 tr in same sp, drop
loop from hook, insert hook in top
of ch-4 and draw dropped loop through
(pc st made), (ch 2, 8 tr in next sp,
drop loop from hook, insert hook in
first tr, draw dropped loop through—
another pc st made) 6 times. Ch 3,
turn. **2nd row:** Sc in first sp, * ch 3,
sc in next sp. Repeat from * across.
Turn. **3rd row:** Sl st in first sp, ch 4,
pc st in same sp, * ch 2, pc st in
next sp. Repeat from * across. Ch 3,
turn. **4th to 11th rows incl:** Repeat
2nd and 3rd rows alternately 4 more
times (2 pc sts on 11th row). Break
off at end of 11th row. Make a bunch
of grapes over each group of tr sps.

LEAF . . . 1st row: Attach Chartreuse
Green to first sp on 2nd row of any
bunch of grapes, ch 5, 5 tr in center tr
of next tr group, ch 3, 5 tr in next sp,
ch 3, 5 tr in center tr of next tr group,
ch 5, sl st in first sp on 2nd row of
next bunch of grapes, ch 3, sl st in
first sp on 4th row. Ch 5, turn. **2nd
row:** (5 tr in center tr of next tr

Heart Napkin Holder S-320

Shown in color on Front Cover

MATERIALS:

J. & P. COATS "KNIT-CRO-SHEEN,"
Art. A.64: 1 ball of No. 126 Spanish Red; and

J. & P. COATS BEST SIX CORD MERCERIZED CROCHET, Art. A.104,
Size 30: 1 ball of White; or

CLARK'S BIG BALL MERCERIZED CROCHET, Art. B.34, Size 30: 1 ball of White.

Milwards Steel Crochet Hooks No. 7 and No. 10.

A hairpin lace staple, 1/2 inch wide . . .
A heart shaped wire napkin holder
. . . 2 yards white satin ribbon,
3/8 inch wide.

HEART . . . Starting at center with Spanish Red and No. 7 hook, ch 25. Join with sl st. **1st rnd:** Ch 3, 38 dc in ring. Join. Now work in rows as follows: **1st row:** Sc in same place as sl st, sc in next 26 dc, ch 2, skip 2 dc, in next dc make 2 dc, ch 3 and 2 dc (shell made). Ch 3, turn. **2nd row:** In sp of shell make 3 dc, ch 3 and 3 dc (shell made over shell); ch 2, skip 1 ch, sc in next ch, sc in back loop of each sc across—hereafter pick up back loop of each sc—ch 2, skip 2 dc on first rnd, shell in next dc. Ch 3, turn. **3rd and 4th rows:** Shell in sp of shell, ch 2, skip 1 ch, sc in next ch, sc in each sc across, sc in next ch, ch 2, shell over shell. Ch 3, turn (31 sc on last row). **5th to 16th rows incl:** Shell over shell, ch 2, skip 1 sc, sc in each sc across to within last sc, ch 2, shell over shell. Ch 3, turn (7 sc on 16th row). **17th row:** Shell over shell, ch 2, skip 2 sc, sc in next 3 sc. Break off. Sew tips of last 2 shells together.

Attach thread where shells were joined and work around heart as follows: Ch 7, tr in same place, * ch 5, sc in next turning chain, ch 5, skip next shell, tr in sp of next shell. Repeat from * across half of heart, ending with sc in last turning chain, ch 5, tr at base of last shell, ch 5, sc in center dc on ring, ch 5, tr at base of

next shell and work around other side of heart to correspond, ending with ch 5, sl st in 4th ch of ch-7. Break off.

EDGING . . . With White and No. 10 hook make a strip of hairpin lace to reach loosely around heart. Break off.

SCALLOPED EDGE . . . 1st row: Keeping the twist in all loops, attach White to first loop, sc in same loop, sc in next 2 loops, * ch 5, sc in next 3 loops. Repeat from * across, ending with sc in last 3 loops, having number of ch-5 loops divisible by 4. Ch 3, turn. **2nd row:** * In next loop make tr, ch 8 and tr; dc in next loop. Repeat from * across, ending with dc in last loop. Ch 6, turn. **3rd row:** * In next ch-8 sp make (dc, ch 1) 6 times and dc; ch 3, dc in next sp, ch 3. Repeat from * across, ending with dc in last sp. Ch 1, turn. **4th row:** 3 sc in first sp, * (in next sp make sc, ch 3 and sc) 6 times; 3 sc in each of next 2 sps. Repeat from * across. Break off.

HEADING . . . Still keeping the twist in all loops, attach White through first 2 loops, sc in same place, * sc through next 2 loops. Repeat from * across. Break off.

Starch lace lightly and press. Sew around heart. Cut ribbon in half and lace through sps between center of heart and shells and tie into a bow at top. With Red make a chain 30 inches long. Attach heart to napkin holder by lacing chain over frame and last rnd of sps on heart. Tie at top. Complete other side the same way.

Hot Plate Mat and Napkin Holder Set S-321

MATERIALS:

J. & P. COATS "KNIT-CRO-SHEEN,"
Art. A.64: 3 balls of White and 7 balls of No. 76 Robinette.

Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 7.

A wire napkin holder 5 inches in diameter; round wire hot plate racks 7, 9 and 11 inches in diameter; oval racks 10 x 15 1/2 inches, and 7 1/4 x 12 1/2 inches.

LARGE ROUND MAT . . . Starting at center with Robinette, ch 4. **1st rnd:** 19 dc in 4th ch from hook. Join with sl st to top of starting chain. **2nd rnd:** Sc in same place as sl st, * ch 3, 2 dc in same place as last sc was made, skip next dc, sc in next dc. Repeat from * around. Join and break off (10 points). **3rd rnd:** Attach White to ch-3 sp on any point, sc in same place, * ch 5, sc in next ch-3 sp. Repeat from * around. Join. **4th rnd:** Ch 3, in next loop make 4 dc, ch 4 and 5 dc; in each remaining loop around make 5 dc, ch 4 and 5 dc. Join. **5th rnd:** Ch 3, * dc in each dc to next sp, in sp make 5 dc, ch 4 and 5 dc. Repeat from * around. Join and break off. **6th rnd:** Attach Robinette to the 6th dc made following any sp and work as for 5th rnd. Join, do not break off. **7th rnd:** Sc in same place as sl st, * ch 8, skip next 8 dc, sc in next dc,

ch 2, skip next 20 dc, sc in next dc. Repeat from * around. Join. **8th rnd:** * In next loop make sc, half dc, 13 dc, half dc and sc, sc in ch-2 sp. Repeat from * around. Join and break off. **9th rnd:** Attach White to the 5th dc preceding any ch-4 sp on 6th rnd, ch 3, * dc in next 4 dc, 7 dc in next sp, dc in next 5 dc, dc in 5th dc preceding next sp. Repeat from * around. Join and break off. **10th rnd:** Attach Robinette to center dc of 7-dc group made in sp, in same place make sc, ch 5 and sc; * ch 5, skip next 3 dc, holding back on hook the last loop of each tr, make 3 tr in next dc, thread over and draw through all loops on hook (cluster made); skip next 8 dc, cluster in next dc, ch 5, skip next 3 dc, in next dc make sc, ch 5 and sc. Repeat from * around. Join. **11th rnd:** Sl st in next loop, ch 4, 2 tr cluster in same loop, (ch 5, 3-tr cluster in same loop) twice; * skip next cluster, in tip of next cluster make cluster, ch 5 and cluster; in next loop at tip of point make (cluster, ch 5) twice and cluster. Repeat from * around. Join. **12th rnd:** Sl st to center of next loop, sc in same loop, * ch 6, sc in next loop. Repeat from * around. Join and break off. **13th rnd:** Attach White to same place as sl st and work as for 4th rnd. **14th to 18th rnds incl:** Work as for 5th to 9th rnds incl. **19th rnd:** Work as for 10th rnd, making sc only at tip of point instead of sc, ch 5 and sc. **20th, 21st and 22nd rnds:** Work as for 12th rnd. Break off at end of 22nd rnd. With Robinette make a chain 45 inches long for a tie. Break off. Lace chain through last rnd of loops. Slip mat over rack and tie ends securely.

MEDIUM ROUND MAT . . . Work as for Large Round Mat until 14 rnds have been completed. **15th rnd:** Attach Robinette to 6th dc made following any sp, ch 3, * dc in next 9 dc, ch 3, dc in 6th dc following next sp. Repeat from * around. Join and break off. **16th rnd:** Attach Robinette through the ch-4 sp on the 14th rnd and the corresponding sp on the 15th rnd, make an sc over both loops, * ch 8, make an sc over both loops of next set of loops. Repeat from * around. Join. **17th and 18th rnds:** Work as for 12th rnd, making ch-8 loops instead of ch-6. Break off. With Robinette make a chain 35 inches long for a tie. Break off. Complete as for Large Round Mat.

SMALL ROUND MAT . . . Work as for Large Round Mat until 12 rnds have been completed. **13th and 14th rnds:** Work as for 12th rnd. Break off. With Robinette make a chain 25 inches long for tie. Break off. Complete as for Large Round Mat.

NAPKIN HOLDER . . . Work as for Large Round Mat until 10 rnds are completed. **11th rnd:** Sc in first loop, * ch 5, sc in next loop. Repeat from * around. Join and break off. With Robinette make a chain 20 inches long. Break off. Complete as for Large Round Mat. Complete other side the same way.

LARGE PLATTER MAT . . . Work as for Large Round Mat until 2 rnds have been completed. Make 2 more pieces same way. **3rd rnd:** Attach White

to ch-3 sp on any point, sc in same place, (ch 5, sc in next ch-3) 9 times; sc in ch-3 sp on any point of second piece, (ch 5, sc in ch-3 sp on next point) 4 times; sc in ch-3 sp on any point of third piece and complete rnd as for first half of rnd. Join. **4th rnd:** Sl st in first 2 ch of next loop, ch 3, 4 dc in same loop, * (in next loop make 5 dc, ch 4 and 5 dc) 7 times; 5 dc in next loop, ch 4, 5 dc in next loop, (in next loop make 5 dc, ch 4 and 5 dc) twice; 5 dc in next loop, ch 4, 5 dc in next loop. Repeat from * once more, ending with 5 dc in last free loop, ch 4. Join to top of ch-3. **5th to 12th rnds incl:** Work as for 5th to 12th rnds of Large Round Mat. Mark off the center 13 loops on each rounded end, having 20 loops between each rounded end. **13th rnd:** Attach White to the first loop on rounded end, ch 3, in same loop make 4 dc, ch 4 and 5 dc, (in next loop make 5 dc, ch 4 and 5 dc) 12 times; (5 dc in next loop, ch 4, 5 dc in next loop) 10 times; (in next loop make 5 dc, ch 4 and 5 dc) 13 times; (5 dc in next loop, ch 4, 5 dc in next loop) 10 times. Join. **14th to 22nd rnds incl:** Work as for 14th to 22nd rnds incl of Large Round Mat. With Robinette make a chain 50 inches long. Break off. Complete as for Large Round Mat.

SMALL PLATTER MAT . . . Work as for Large Platter Mat until 12 rnds have been completed. **13th and 14th rnds:** Work as for 12th rnd. Break off. With Robinette make a chain 45 inches long. Break off. Complete as for Large Round Mat.

Pot Holders S-322

Shown in color on Front Cover

MATERIALS:

J. & P. COATS "KNIT-CRO-SHEEN," Art. A.64: 1 ball each of No. 10-A Canary Yellow and No. 123-A Flamingo; No. 25 Crystal Blue and No. 68 Skipper Blue; No. 26-B Bright Nile Green and No. 49-A Killarney.

Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 7.
3 bone rings.

BACK . . . Starting at center with Canary Yellow, ch 2. **1st rnd:** 9 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Join with sl st in back loop of first sc. Hereafter pick up back loop only. **2nd rnd:** Ch 4, 2 tr in same place as sl st, 3 tr in each sc around. Join to top of ch-4. **3rd rnd:** Ch 4, tr in same place as sl st, 2 tr in each tr around. Join and break off. **4th rnd:** Attach Flamingo to same place as sl st, sc in same place, sc in each tr around, increasing 6 sc evenly around—to inc 1 sc, make 2 sc in 1 st. Join with sl st. Hereafter pick up both loops. **5th rnd:** Sc in same place as sl st, * ch 5, skip 1 sc, sc in next sc, ch 5, skip 2 sc, sc in next sc. Repeat from * around. Join with sl st in first sc. **6th rnd:** Sl st in first ch-5 loop, ch 3, in same loop make 2 dc, ch 2 and 3 dc; * sc in next loop, in next loop make 3 dc, ch 2 and 3 dc (shell

made). Repeat from * around, ending with sc in last loop. Join to top of ch-3. **7th rnd:** Sl st to next ch-2 loop, ch 3, in same loop make 3 dc, ch 3 and 4 dc; in each loop around make 4 dc, ch 3 and 4 dc. Join to top of ch-3. **8th rnd:** Sl st to next ch-3 loop, ch 4, in same loop make 4 tr, ch 3 and 5 tr; in each loop around make 5 tr, ch 3 and 5 tr. Join to top of ch-4. **9th rnd:** Sl st to next ch-3 loop, ch 4, in same loop make 5 tr, ch 3 and 6 tr; in each loop around make 6 tr, ch 3 and 6 tr. Join to top of ch-4. **10th rnd:** Sl st to next ch-3 loop, ch 5, 14 d tr in same loop, 15 d tr in each loop around. Join to top of ch-5. Break off.

FRONT . . . Make another piece the same way.

JOINING . . . With wrong sides together, attach double strand of Canary Yellow to first free sc between any 2 groups on 4th rnd of pot holder and, working through both thicknesses, sc in same place, * (ch 1, sc between 2 shells on next rnd) 4 times; 2, sc between shells on last rnd, skip 1 d tr, sc in next 13 d tr, sc between shell in work and next shell, ch 2 and, working toward center, (sc between next 2 shells, ch 1) 4 times; sc in first sc between shells on 4th rnd, sc in next sc and working toward outer edge, repeat from * around. Join and break off.

CENTER TRIMMING . . . With right side facing, attach single strand of Canary Yellow to any free sc loop on first rnd, sc in same place, * ch 5, sc in next sc, ch 5, sc in same sc. Repeat from * around. Join with sl st to first free sc loop, then turn and, working into same sts, make another rnd of loops the same way. Join and break off. Make 2 more rnds of loops the same way in free loops on each of the next 2 rnds.

With Canary Yellow, sc closely over bone ring. Sew ring between any 2 shells.

Make 2 more pot holders the same way, making one pot holder of No. 25 Crystal Blue and No. 68 Skipper Blue and the other pot holder of No. 26-B Bright Nile Green and No. 49-A Killarney.

Rolling Pin Cover S-323

Shown in color on Front Cover

MATERIALS:

J. & P. COATS "KNIT-CRO-SHEEN," Art. A.64: 1 ball of No. 123-A Flamingo.

Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 7.

A rolling pin . . . 3 cup hooks . . . 1¼ yards yellow satin ribbon, ⅜ inch wide . . . A brass ring.

Starting at long side, make a chain 2 inches longer than roller of rolling pin. **1st row:** Dc in 4th ch from hook, dc in each ch across. Ch 3, turn. **2nd row:** Skip first dc, dc in each dc across, dc in top of turning chain. Ch 3, turn. Repeat 2nd row until piece is long enough to reach around rolling pin. Now, working across side, make handle

as follows: **1st row:** Sc in side of first st on each row across. Ch 1, turn. **2nd row:** Sc in each sc across. Ch 1, turn. Repeat 2nd row until piece is slightly longer than handle. Break off. Work across other side the same way.

Insert rolling pin and sew up seam. Draw ends in tightly and sew securely. Space hooks evenly and screw into rolling pin. Cut 18 inches of ribbon, place ring at center and tie in a knot. Sew ends of ribbon to each side of rolling pin. Cut remaining ribbon in half and tie a bow around each handle.

group, ch 3, 5 tr in next sp, ch 3) twice; 5 tr in center tr of next group, ch 5, sl st in first sp on 4th row of bunch of grapes, ch 3, sl st in first sp on 6th row. Ch 5, turn. **3rd row:** (5 tr in center tr of next tr group, ch 3) 4 times; 5 tr in center tr of next tr group, ch 5, sl st in first sp of 6th row of bunch of grapes, ch 3, sl st in first sp on 8th row. Ch 5, turn. **4th row:** (7 tr in center tr of next tr group, ch 3) 4 times; 7 tr in center tr of next tr group, ch 5, sl st in first sp on 8th row of bunch of grapes, ch 3, sl st in first sp on 10th row. Ch 5, turn. **5th row:** (9 tr in center tr of next tr group, ch 3) 4 times; 9 tr in center tr of next tr group, ch 5, sl st in first sp on 10th row of bunch of grapes. Break off and turn. **6th row:** Skip first tr group, attach thread to center tr of next tr group, ch 4, 10 tr in same place, (ch 3, 11 tr in center tr of next tr group) twice. Break off and turn. **7th row:** Attach thread to center tr of center tr group, ch 4, 10 tr in same place. Break off. Work other leaves between bunches of grapes the same way.

Attach Hunter's Green to center tr on last White rnd at base of any leaf and, working toward edge of doily, (ch 4, sc in sp between first and 2nd tr groups on next row) 6 times. Break off. Attach thread to same place and, working toward edge of doily, ch 4, sc in sp between last and next to last tr groups on next row) 6 times. Break off. Attach thread to sp between first and 2nd groups on first row of leaf and, working over sps as before, (ch 4, sc in sp between next 2 tr groups) 6 times. Break off.

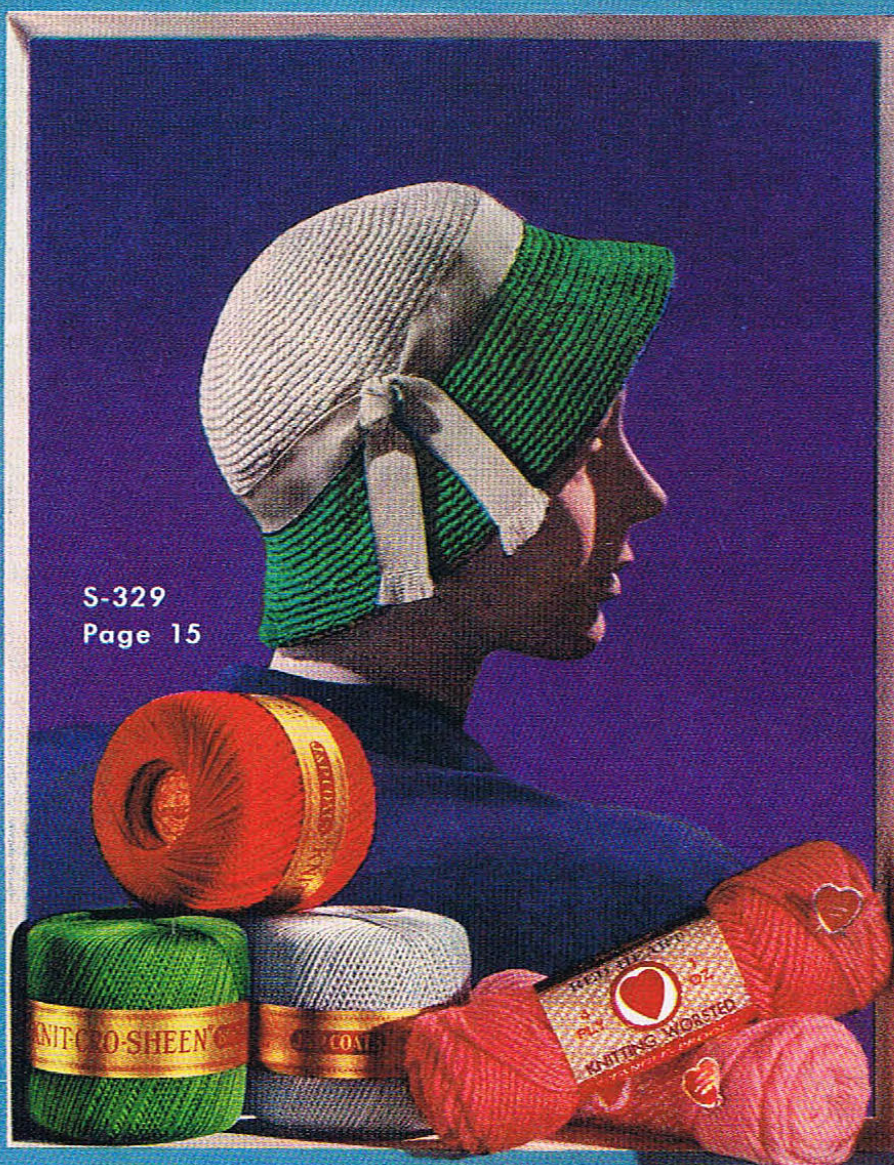
Attach thread to sp between 2nd and 3rd tr groups on first row of leaf and work as before. Complete other leaves the same way.

EDGING . . . Attach Hunter's Green to first st on first tr group on any leaf, sc in same place, ** (ch 4, sc in 3rd ch from hook—picot made—skip 1 tr, sc in next tr) 4 times; * ch 4, sc in first st on next group, (ch 1, picot, skip 1 tr, sc in next tr) 5 times. Repeat from * 2 more times, ch 4, sc in first st on next group, (ch 1, picot, skip 1 st, sc in next st) 4 times; sc in first free st on next leaf. Repeat from ** around. Join and break off.

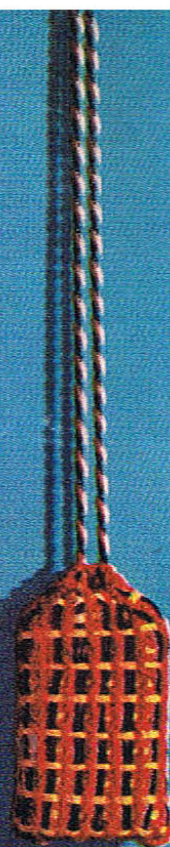

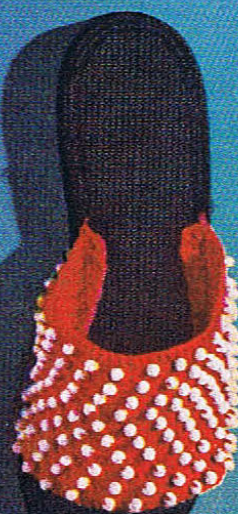

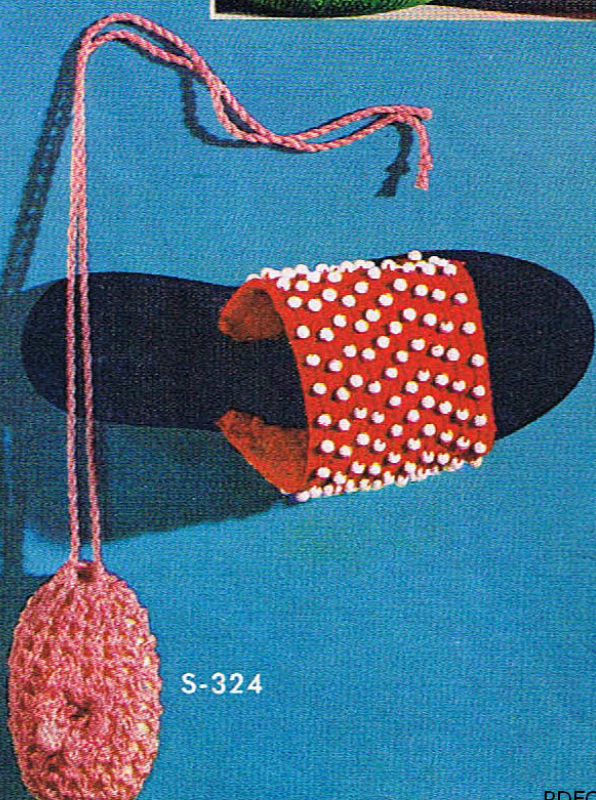

MATERIALS:

J. & P. COATS "KNIT-CRO-SHEEN,"
Art. A.64: 1 ball of No. 46-A Mid
Rose.

Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 7.

Starting at bottom, ch 10. Join with
sl st to form ring. **1st rnd:** (Sc in
ring, ch 5) 16 times. Do not join. **2nd
rnd:** * Sc in next loop, ch 5. Repeat
from * around. **3rd rnd:** Sc in next
loop, * ch 4, sc in 3rd ch from hook
(picot made), ch 3, sc in next loop.
Repeat from * around. **4th to 13th
rnds incl:** Repeat 3rd rnd. **14th rnd:**
* Ch 5, sc in next loop. Repeat from *
around. Join and break off.

ROSETTE . . . Starting at center,
ch 10. Join with sl st to form ring.
1st rnd: (Sc in ring, ch 3) 6 times.
2nd rnd: In each loop around make
sc, half dc, 3 dc, half dc and sc. Join.
3rd rnd: Sc around bar of sc on first

Repeat from * around. Join. **4th rnd:**
In each loop around make sc, half dc,

EDGING—FIRST DAISY . . . Starting at center with Dk. Yellow Tatting-Crochet, ch 2. **1st rnd:** Working over 2 strands of "Knit-Cro-Sheen," make 8 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Sl st in first sc made. Break off. **2nd rnd:** Attach White to any sc, sc in same place, * ch 3, sc in next sc. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 3, sl st in first sc. Break off.

SECOND DAISY . . . Work center same as for First Daisy. **2nd rnd:** Attach White to any sc, sc in same place, ch 3, sc in next sc, ch 1, sl st in any free loop on First Daisy, ch 1, sc in next sc on Daisy in work, ch 3, complete as for First Daisy. Break off.

Make daisies in this manner until edging is length desired, joining each daisy to previous one as Second Daisy was joined to First Daisy, leaving 3 loops free on each side of joining.

HEADING . . . With right side of work facing, attach White to 2nd free loop preceding last joining, sc in same place, * ch 7, sc in center loop on next daisy. Repeat from * across, ending with sc in 2nd loop on last daisy. Break off.

LARGE DAISY (Make 3) . . . Work center as for First Daisy, do not break

off thread. **1st rnd:** Sc in each sc around. Join with sl st. Break off. **2nd rnd:** Attach White to any sc, sc in same place, * ch 3, in the same sc make 2 dc, ch 3 and sc; sc in next sc. Repeat from * around. Join with sl st to first sc. Break off.

Sew Edging neatly along outer edges of bib. With Nile Green Embroidery Floss, embroider stems and leaves as illustrated. Sew 3 large daisies in place.

ROSE . . . Starting at center, ch 7. Join with sl st to form ring. **1st rnd:** Ch 6, (dc in ring, ch 3) 5 times. Join with sl st to 3rd ch of ch-6 (6 sps). **2nd rnd:** In each sp around make sc, half dc, 3 dc, half dc and sc. **3rd rnd:** * Ch 5, sc (from back of work) in next dc on first rnd. Repeat from * around, ending with ch-5, sc in same place as sl st on first rnd. **4th rnd:** In each loop around make sc, half dc, 5 dc, half dc and sc. **5th rnd:** * Ch 6, sc in the sc between next 2 petals on 3rd rnd. Repeat from * around, ending with sc between last and first petals. **6th rnd:** In each loop around make sc, half dc, 7 dc, half dc and sc. **7th rnd:** * Ch 7, sc in sc between next 2 petals on 5th rnd. Repeat from * around.

8th rnd: In each loop around make sc, half dc, 9 dc, half dc and sc. **9th rnd:** * Ch 6, sc in sc between next 2 petals on 7th rnd. Repeat from * around. **10th rnd:** * Ch 6, sc in next loop, ch 6, sc in next sc. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 3, dc in the base of starting chain. **11th rnd:** Sc in loop just formed, * ch 5, sl st in 3rd ch from hook (picot made), ch 3, picot, ch 2, sc in next loop. Repeat from * around, ending with sl st in first sc. **12th rnd:** Sl st to center ch (between picots) on next loop, sc in same place, * ch 2, picot, ch 3, picot, ch 2, sc in next loop. Repeat from * around, ending with sl st in first sc. **13th rnd:** Sl st to center ch (between picots) on next loop, sc in same place, * ch 9, sc between picots on next loop. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 4, d tr in first sc. **14th to 17th rnds incl:** Sc in loop just formed, * ch 9, sc in next loop. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 4, d tr in first sc. Break off. Place disk in holder.

CORD . . . Make a chain $7\frac{1}{2}$ inches long. Break off. Lace cord through last rnd of loops. Tie in place. Lace ribbon around narrow edge of disk. Tie into a bow.

Ch 1, turn (6 group sts). **2nd row:** Make a group st in back loop of first sc and in back loop of next 5 sc, sc in back loop of next sc. Ch 1, turn. Repeat 2nd row until piece is long enough to reach around glass, having an even number of rows. Break off. Sew narrow ends together and sew to bottom piece.

Jewel, ch 2. **1st rnd:** 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. **2nd rnd:** 2 sc in each sc around. Join. **3rd rnd:** * 2 sc in next sc (1 sc increased), sc in next sc. Repeat from * around. Join. Inc 6 sc evenly on each rnd until piece measures same as bottom of glass, sl st in next sc.

SIDE PIECE . . . 1st rnd: Ch 4, * skip 1 sc, dc in back loop of next sc, ch 1. Repeat from * around, being sure to have the number of sps divisible by 8. Join to 3rd ch of ch-4. **2nd to 9th rnds incl:** Ch 4, * dc in next dc, ch 1. Repeat from * around. Join. Break off at end of 9th rnd.

Using a double strand of White, embroider flowers as shown in illustration, making 4 overcast sts over 1 sp for each petal.

 Flamingo and No. 64 Platinum.

BASE . . . Starting at center with Platinum, work as for Base of No. S-341. Break off.

SIDE PIECE . . . Attach Flamingo to first sc, ch 2, half dc in same place, half dc in each sc around. Join. **2nd to 19th rnds incl:** Ch 2, half dc in back loop of each half dc around. Join. Break off at end of 19th rnd. **20th rnd:** Attach Platinum to first half dc, sc in each half dc around. Join and break off.

TRIM . . . 1st rnd: With top facing, attach Platinum to free loop of any half dc on 2nd rnd, sc in each free loop around. Join and break off. **2nd rnd:** Attach Platinum to free loop of any half dc on 6th rnd, sc in same place, * skip 2 half dc, 9 dc in next half dc (shell made), skip 2 half dc, sc in next half dc. Repeat from * around. Join and break off.

With Platinum make a rnd of sc in free loops of half dc's on 10th and

12th rnds. Then with Platinum make a rnd of shells in free loops of half dc's on 16th rnd.

 Art. A.64: 1 ball of No. 76 Robinette.

Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 7.

BASE . . . Work as for Base of No. S-341. Do not break off.

SIDE PIECE . . . 1st rnd: Ch 2, half dc in back loop of each sc around. Join. **2nd rnd:** Ch 2, picking up both loops, half dc in each half dc around. Join. **3rd rnd:** Sc in back loop of each half dc around. Join. **4th rnd:** Ch 3, 3 dc in same place as sl st, drop loop from hook, insert hook in top of ch 3 and draw dropped loop through (pc st made), * ch 1, skip 1 sc, 4 dc in next sc, drop loop from hook, insert hook in first dc and complete a pc st. Repeat from * around. Join. **5th rnd:** Sc in same place as sl st, * sc in next sp, sc in next pc st. Repeat from * around. Join. Repeat first to 5th rnds incl 2 more times, then repeat first and 2nd rnds once more. Break off at end of last rnd.

Rose Jacket S-344

MATERIALS:

J. & P. COATS "KNIT-CRO-SHEEN,"
 Art. A.64: 1 ball each of No. 1
 White and No. 46-A Mid Rose.

Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 7.

BASE . . . Starting at center with Mid Rose work as for Base of No. S-341. Break off.

TOP PIECE . . . Starting at long side with White, make a chain long enough to reach loosely around glass. **1st row:** Dc in 6th ch from hook, * ch 1, skip 1 ch, dc in next ch. Repeat

Starting at narrow edge ch 31. **1st row:** Dc in 4th ch from hook, (ch 2, skip 2 ch, in next ch make dc, ch 3 and dc; ch 2, skip 2 ch, dc in next ch, skip 3 ch, dc in next ch) twice; ch 2, skip 2 ch, in next ch make dc, ch 3 and dc; ch 2, skip 2 ch, dc in last 2 ch. Ch 3, turn. **2nd row:** Skip first dc, dc in next dc, ch 2, dc in next dc, (ch 3, dc in next dc, ch 5, skip 2 dc, dc in next dc) twice; ch 3, dc in next dc, ch 2, dc in next dc and in top of turning chain. Ch 3, turn. **3rd row:** Skip first dc, dc in next dc, (ch 2, dc in next 2 dc, ch 2, skip 2 ch, in next ch make dc, ch 3 and dc) twice; ch 2, dc in next 2 dc, ch 2, dc in next dc, dc in top of turning chain. Ch 3, turn. **4th row:** Skip first dc, dc in next dc, (ch 5, skip 2 dc, dc in next dc, ch 3, dc in next dc) twice; ch 5, skip 2 dc, dc in next dc, dc in top of turning chain. Ch 3, turn. **5th row:** Skip first dc, dc in next dc, (ch 2, skip 2 ch, in next ch make dc, ch 3 and dc; ch 2, dc in next 2 dc) twice; ch 2, skip 2 ch, in next ch make dc, ch 3 and dc; ch 2, dc in next dc, dc in top of turning chain. Ch 3, turn. Repeat 2nd to 5th rows incl until piece measures 16½ inches, ending with 3rd row. Break off. Starch strips lightly and press.

Cut 9 strips of ribbon the same length as Insertion. Cut a V at one end (lower end) of each piece. Sew strips together alternately, beginning and ending with a ribbon strip. Gather across top to measure 14 inches. Sew remaining ribbon across top for band and ties.

Repeat from * around, ending with ch 3, tr in first sc. **8th to 13th rnds incl:** Repeat 7th rnd. Break off. Place disk in holder.

CORD . . . Make a chain 7½ inches long. Break off. Lace cord through last rnd of loops. Tie in place. Lace ribbon around narrow edge of disk. Tie into a bow.

Two-tone Hanger **S-336**

Illustrated on Page 9

MATERIALS:

J. & P. COATS "KNIT-CRO-SHEEN," Art. A.64: 1 ball each of No. 1 White and No. 48 Hunter's Green.

Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 4.
1 yard white satin ribbon, ¾ inch wide.

A wooden dress hanger.

Use one strand each of White and Hunter's Green throughout.

Starting at center of one end, ch 2. **1st rnd:** 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. **2nd rnd:** 2 sc in each sc around. Sc in each sc around until piece is long enough to cover one end of hanger. Join and break off. Make another piece the same way. Slip pieces over each end of hanger and sew together at center. Cover hook with ribbon. Tie remaining ribbon into a bow around hook.

Sunbonnet Sachet **S-337**

Illustrated on Page 9

MATERIALS:

CLARK'S O.N.T. BEST SIX CORD MERCERIZED CROCHET, Art. B.4, Size 30: 1 ball of No. 9 Yellow.

Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 10.
½ yard of narrow white lace.
1 yard of red grosgrain ribbon, ⅝ inch wide.

Cotton and sachet.

Piece of yellow material for lining.

Starting at back make a chain 21½ inches long. **1st row:** Dc in 4th ch from hook, dc in next 18 ch, 3 dc in next ch, dc in next 20 ch. Cut off

remaining chain. Ch 3, turn. **2nd and 3rd rows:** Skip first dc, dc in each dc across, dc in top of turning chain. Ch 3, turn. **4th to 10th rows incl:** Dc in first dc (inc made), dc in each dc to within 1 dc of center dc, 2 dc in next dc, dc in center dc, 2 dc in next dc, dc in each remaining dc across, 2 dc in top of turning chain. Ch 3, turn. **11th to 16th rows incl:** Holding back on hook the last loop of each dc make dc in next 4 dc, thread over and draw through all loops on hook (3 dc decreased), dc in each dc to within 1 dc of center dc, 2 dc in next dc, dc in center dc, 2 dc in next dc, dc in each remaining dc to within last 4 sts, work off last 4 sts as 1 dc. Ch 3, turn. Break off at end of 16th row. Attach thread to side of end dc on first row, sc closely around three sides, ending at end dc on opposite side of first row. Ch 1, turn. Sc in each sc across. Break off.

Gather lace to fit around entire Bonnet. Sew in place. Cut lining material slightly larger than Bonnet. Turn under small hem and sew neatly to Bonnet, placing cotton and sachet between lining and Bonnet. Fold in half and sew up back. Trim with ribbon.

MATERIALS:

CLARK'S O.N.T. BEST SIX CORD MERCERIZED CROCHET, Art. B.4, Size 30: 1 ball of No. 8 Blue.

Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 10.
½ yard of white satin ribbon, ¼ inch wide.

A few flowers.

Piece of blue material for lining.

Cotton and sachet.

CROWN . . . Starting at center, ch 2. **1st rnd:** 8 sc in 2nd ch from hook. **2nd rnd:** 2 sc in each sc around. **3rd rnd:** Sc in each sc, increasing 8 sc evenly around—to inc 1 sc, make 2 sc in 1 sc. Repeat 3rd rnd until crown measures 1½ inches in diameter. Join with sl st.

BEADING . . . Ch 5, * skip 1 sc, tr in next sc, ch 1. Repeat from * around. Join to 4th ch of ch-5.

BRIM . . . **1st rnd:** 2 sc in each ch-1 sp around. Join. **2nd rnd:** Ch 3, dc in same place as sl st, * dc in next 2 sc, 2 dc in next sc. Repeat from * around. Join. **3rd to 9th rnds incl:** Ch 3, dc in same place as sl st, dc in each dc increasing 14 dc evenly around—to inc 1 dc, make 2 dc in 1 dc. Join. **Next rnd:** Ch 1, sc in each dc around. Join and break off.

Stuff crown with cotton and sachet. Cut lining material slightly larger than brim of hat. Turn under small hem and sew lining to brim. Lace ribbon through Beading and tie into a bow. Sew flowers in place.

Art. A.64: 3 balls of No. 65 Beauty Pink; 2 balls of No. 9 Yellow and 1 ball of No. 131 Fudge Brown; and

J. & P. COATS or CLARK'S O.N.T. SIX STRAND EMBROIDERY FLOSS,
Art. A. or B.11: 1 skein each of No. 76 China Blue, No. 12 Black, No. 140 Signal Red and No. 32 Purple.

Milwards Steel Crochet Hooks No. 4 and No. 7.

Cotton batting for stuffing . . . $\frac{1}{4}$ yard of white organdy and 2 yards of white eyelet ruffling, 1 inch wide for petticoat . . . $\frac{1}{2}$ yard green ribbon, $\frac{1}{2}$ inch wide . . . A small bunch of purple flowers . . . 3 snap fasteners . . . Small white beads.

Use double strand of Beauty Pink throughout.

GAUGE: 6 sc make 1 inch; 5 rows make 1 inch.

BODY . . . Starting at bottom with Beauty Pink and No. 4 hook, ch 16. **1st rnd:** 3 sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each ch across, 3 sc in last ch; working along opposite side of starting chain, make sc in each ch across. **2nd and 3rd rnds:** Sc in each sc around, increasing 3 sc evenly over rounded ends—to inc 1 sc, make 2 sc in 1 sc. Work without increasing until piece measures $2\frac{1}{2}$ inches, then dec 2 sc on each rnd until 32 sc remain—to dec 1 sc, work off 2 sc as 1 sc. Work one rnd without decreasing, then inc 2 sc on each of next 5 rnds. Work without increasing until piece measures 6 inches. Dec 4 sc on each of next 5 rnds. Stuff Body firmly with cotton and continue decreasing until 10 sc remain. Join and break off. Sew up opening.

HEAD . . . Starting at top, ch 2. **1st rnd:** 7 sc in 2nd ch from hook. **2nd rnd:** 2 sc in each sc around. **3rd to 7th rnds incl:** Inc 7 sc evenly on each rnd. Work without increasing until piece measures 2 inches. Dec 7 sc evenly on each of next 4 rnds. Stuff Head firmly with cotton and continue decreasing until all sc's have been worked off. Break off. Sew Head to Body. Embroider face with China Blue, Signal Red and Black embroidery floss.

LEG (Make 2) . . . Starting at bottom, ch 2. **1st rnd:** 3 sc in 2nd ch from hook. **2nd, 3rd and 4th rnds:** Inc 3 sc evenly on each rnd. Work without increasing until piece measures 2 inches, then inc 1 sc on each of next 6 rnds. Work without increasing until piece measures $8\frac{1}{2}$ inches. Stuff leg firmly with cotton, dec 3 sc on each rnd until all sc's have been worked off. Break off. Sew legs to body. Embroider shoes with Purple embroidery floss.

ARM (Make 2) . . . Work as for Leg until 3 rnds have been completed. Work without increasing until piece

measures $1\frac{1}{4}$ inches, then inc 1 sc on each of next 6 rnds. Work without increasing until piece measures $7\frac{1}{2}$ inches. Complete as for Leg. Sew Arms to Body. Tie a piece of Beauty Pink around arm 1 inch from end to form wrist.

HAIR . . . With double strand of Fudge Brown, work as for Head until 7 rnds have been completed. Work 5 more rnds without increasing. Join and break off.

BANGS . . . With right side facing, draw thread through base of any sc on 5th rnd to base of sc on 4th rnd and, working over sc's, draw loop through, thread over and draw through loop on hook, draw loop on hook out to measure $\frac{1}{2}$ inch (loop st made), retaining all loop sts on hook, insert hook in next sc, draw thread through, thread over and draw through loop on hook, then draw loop on hook out to measure same as previous loop st. Make 8 more loop sts. Break off. Attach thread through sc on 4th rnd preceding first sc made on first row of Bangs and make 12 loop sts across. Break off. Make 3 more rows of loop sts the same way, having 1 loop st more at beginning and end of each row. Sew to Head.

BRAID (Make 2) . . . Cut 24 strands of Fudge Brown each 36 inches long. Divide these strands into 3 equal groups and make a braid. Roll Braids to form buns and sew to each side of head. String beads and place around neck. Sew a bead to each side of head for earrings.

DRESS—Bodice . . . Starting at bottom with Yellow and No. 7 hook, ch 50 to reach loosely around doll's waist. **1st row:** Dc in 4th ch from hook and in each ch across. Ch 3, turn. **2nd row:** Skip first dc, dc in each dc, increasing 5 dc evenly across, dc in top of turning chain. Ch 3, turn. **3rd row:** Skip first dc, dc in each dc across, dc in top of turning chain. Ch 3, turn. **4th row:** Work as for 2nd row, increasing 3 dc instead of 5. **5th to 8th rows incl:** Repeat 3rd row. Break off at end of 8th row.

SKIRT . . . 1st row: Attach Yellow to opposite side of starting chain on Bodice, ch 4, 2 tr in same ch, 3 tr in each ch across. Ch 4, turn. **2nd, 3rd and 4th rows:** Skip first tr, tr in each tr across, tr in top of turning chain. Ch 4, turn. **5th to 12th rows incl:** Skip first tr, * tr in next 6 tr, 2 tr in next tr. Repeat from * across. Ch 4, turn. At end of 12th row, ch 1, turn. **13th row:** Sc in first tr, * skip 2 tr, 6 dc in next tr, skip 2 tr, sc in next tr. Repeat from * across, ending with sc in top of turning chain. Break off.

SLEEVE (Make 2) . . . Starting at top, ch 32. **1st row:** 2 tr in 5th ch from hook and in each ch across. Ch 4, turn. **2nd and 3rd rows:** Skip first tr, tr in each tr across, tr in top of turning chain. Ch 4, turn. **4th row:** Skip first tr, * work off next 2 tr as 1 tr. Repeat from * across. Ch 1, turn. **5th row:** Sc in each tr across. Break off.

Sew up sleeve seams. Sew up back seam of dress leaving a 4-inch opening. Sew sleeves to dress. Sew 3 snap fasteners to back opening. Make a petticoat of organdy and sew 2 rows of eyelet ruffling around bottom. Tie green ribbon around doll's waist. Sew a few flowers to each side of head and remaining flowers to waist.

MATERIALS:

J. & P. COATS "KNIT-CRO-SHEEN,"
Art. A.64: 1 ball each of No. 70 Blue Jewel, No. 123-A Flamingo, No. 65 Beauty Pink, No. 12 Black and No. 10-A Canary Yellow.

Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 7.

A scrap of yellow printed percale for scarf . . . Cotton batting for stuffing . . . A snap fastener.

GAUGE: 9 sc make 1 inch; 9 rows make 1 inch.

BODY—Front . . . Starting at bottom of one leg with Blue Jewel, ch 15. **1st row:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. Ch 1, turn. **2nd row:** Sc in each sc across. Ch 1, turn. Repeat 2nd row until piece measures 4 inches. Break off. Make another piece the same way. At end of last row do not break off. Ch 1, turn. Sc in each sc across, then sc in each sc across first piece made. Ch 1, turn. **Next row:** Sc in each sc across. Ch 1, turn. Repeat last row until piece measures $5\frac{1}{2}$ inches in all. Break off and turn.

TOP . . . 1st row: Attach Flamingo to first sc, sc in each sc across. Ch 1, turn. Repeat last row until Top measures $\frac{3}{4}$ inch. Ch 29 for arm, turn. Attach a separate piece of thread to opposite end of last row, ch 28. Break off. **Next row:** Pick up main thread, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each ch, each sc and in each ch across other arm. Ch 1, turn. Work in sc pattern until Top measures 2 inches. Break off.

Work Back same as Front. Sew Back and Front pieces together, leaving opening at each arm and 1 inch open at center of last row for neck. Attach Flamingo to neck opening and sc in each sc around. Join and break off.

HAND . . . 1st rnd: Attach Beauty Pink to end of arm and make 28 sc closely around. **2nd rnd:** Sc in each sc around, decreasing 4 sc evenly around—to dec 1 sc, work off 2 sc as 1 sc. Repeat 2nd rnd until all sc's have been worked off. Break off. Complete other hand the same way. Stuff Body firmly with cotton.

HEAD . . . Starting at top with Beauty Pink, ch 2. **1st rnd:** 7 sc in 2nd ch from hook. **2nd rnd:** 2 sc in each sc around. **3rd rnd:** * 2 sc in next sc

A few yards of Black, Blue and Red
Embroidery Floss for eyes and mouth.
2 yards of red grosgrain ribbon,
1/2 inch wide . . . 1 yard of white
lace . . . 1/4 yard of yellow material
for petticoat . . . Cotton batting for
stuffing . . . A feather . . . 2 snap
fasteners . . . Beads.

Use double strand of Beauty
Pink throughout.

NECK . . . With Beauty Pink and
No. 4 hook, ch 8. **1st rnd:** 3 sc in 2nd
ch from hook, sc in each ch across, 3 sc
in last ch; working along opposite side
of starting chain make sc in each ch
across. **2nd rnd:** Sc in each sc around.
Repeat the 2nd rnd until neck measures
3/8 inch.

To Shape Body: **1st rnd:** Sc in each
sc, increasing 4 sc evenly around—to
inc 1 sc, make 2 sc in 1 sc. **2nd to
8th rnds incl:** Sc in each sc, increas-
ing 3 sc evenly on each rnd. **9th to
19th rnds incl:** Sc in each sc, decreas-
ing 2 sc on each rnd—to *dec 1 sc,
work off 2 sc as 1 sc.*

Stuff body firmly with cotton batting
and continue as follows:

HIPS . . . 1st to 7th rnds incl: Sc in
each sc, increasing 3 sc evenly on each
rnd. **8th to 12th rnds incl:** Sc in each
sc around. **13th to 18th rnds incl:**
Sc in each sc, decreasing 1 sc on each
rnd (34 sc on last rnd). Break off.

Stuff Hips firmly with cotton batting.
Divide remaining sts on last rnd in
half for legs.

LEG . . . Attach thread, sc in each sc
around one leg opening, sc in each sc
around until leg measures 2 1/4 inches.
Dec 1 sc on every other rnd until 12
sc remain. Work without decreasing
until leg measures 4 3/4 inches. Break
off. Stuff leg firmly with cotton batting.
Work other leg to correspond.

FOOT (Make 2) . . . 1st rnd: Ch 2,
6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. **2nd rnd:**
2 sc in each sc around. Work without
increasing until foot measures 7/8 inch.

Now work in rows as follows: **1st
row:** Dec 1 sc, sc in next 3 sc, dec
1 sc. Ch 1, turn. **2nd row:** Dec 1 sc,
sc in next sc, dec 1 sc. Ch 1, turn. **3rd
row:** Work off last 3 sc as 1 sc. Break
off. Stuff Foot firmly with cotton
batting.

ARM (Make 2) . . . 1st rnd: Ch 2,
6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. **2nd rnd:**
2 sc in each sc around. Work without

increasing until piece measures 1 inch.
Dec 1 sc on next rnd. Work without
decreasing for 1 rnd. Inc 2 sc on next
rnd. Work without increasing until
piece measures 1 3/4 inches. Sc in each
sc around, increasing 1 sc every 3/4
inch until piece measures 4 1/4 inches
in all.

Now work in rows as follows: **1st
row:** Dec 1 sc, sc in next 5 sc, dec
1 sc. Ch 1, turn. **2nd row:** Dec 1 sc,
sc in next 3 sc, dec 1 sc. Ch 1, turn.
3rd row: Dec 1 sc, sc in next sc, dec
1 sc. Ch 1, turn. **4th row:** Work off
last 3 sc as 1 sc. Break off. Stuff Arm
firmly with cotton batting.

HEAD . . . 1st rnd: Ch 2, 6 sc in
2nd ch from hook. **2nd rnd:** 2 sc in
each sc around. **3rd and 4th rnds:**
* 2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc. Repeat
from * around (27 sc). Sc in each sc
around until piece measures 1 1/2 inches.
Next rnd: * Dec 1 sc, sc in next sc.
Repeat from * around. Now dec 6 sc
evenly on each rnd until 6 sc remain.
Break off.

Stuff Head firmly with cotton batting.
Sew up opening. Sew Head, Arms and
Feet in place.

DRESS-SKIRT . . . With single
strand of Brown and No. 7 hook,
make a chain to reach around doll's
waist. **1st row:** Sc in 2nd ch from
hook, * (draw loop on hook out to
measure 3/8 inch, thread over and draw
loop through, insert hook between
single and double loops and draw a
loop through, thread over and draw
through 2 loops on hook—knot st
made—make another knot st, skip 1 ch,
sc in next ch) twice; make 2 knot sts,
sc in next ch. Repeat from * across.
Make 2 knot sts. Turn. **2nd and 3rd
rows:** * Sc under double loop of next
knot st to the right of knot, sc under
double loop of next knot st to the left
of same knot, make 2 knot sts. Repeat
from * across. Make 2 knot sts, turn.
Do not turn at end of 3rd row. Sl st
in center of next knot st. Now work
in rnds as follows: **1st rnd:** * Make
2 knot sts, sc in next 2 knot sts. Repeat
from * around. Do not join at end
of rnd. Repeat first rnd until Skirt
reaches doll's ankles. Join and break off.

BODICE . . . Attach Brown to first ch
on opposite side of starting chain of
Skirt. **1st row:** * Make 2 knot sts, skip
1 ch, sc in next ch. Repeat from *
across. Make 2 knot sts, turn. **2nd
and 3rd rows:** * Sc in next 2 knot sts,
make 2 knot sts. Repeat from * across.
Make 2 knot sts, turn. **4th row:** * Sc
in next 2 knot sts, ch 3. Repeat from *
across, ending with sc in last 2 knot sts.
Join and break off.

SLEEVE (Make 2) . . . With Brown,
ch 20. **1st row:** Sc in 2nd ch from
hook, * make 2 knot sts, skip 2 ch,
sc in next ch. Repeat from * across.
Make 2 knot sts, turn. **2nd and 3rd
rows:** Repeat 2nd and 3rd rows of
Bodice. **4th row:** * Sc in next 2 knot
sts, ch 2. Repeat from * across, ending
with sc in last 2 knot sts. Break off.
Sew Sleeves in place. Sc closely around
neck and sleeves, drawing in to fit.
Place ribbon around waist and tie in
a bow.

SLIPPER (Make 2) . . . Starting at
center with Brown, ch 8. **1st rnd:** 3 sc
in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each ch
across, 3 sc in last ch; working along
opposite side of starting chain, make
sc in each ch across. **2nd and 3rd
rnds:** Sc in each sc around, increasing
3 sc evenly on each end. **4th rnd:**
Sc in each sc around. Join in back loop
of first sc. **5th rnd:** Ch 3, picking up
back loop only, dc in each sc around.
Join to top of ch-3. **6th rnd:** Dec 1 sc,
sc in next 2 dc, dec 1 sc, sc in each
remaining dc around. Join and break off.

GLOVE (Make 2) . . . Starting at
top of Glove with Robinette and No.
7 hook, ch 24. Join with sl st. **1st rnd:**
Sc in each ch around. **2nd to 5th rnds
incl:** Sc in each sc around. **6th rnd:**
Sc in each sc, decreasing 4 sc evenly
around. **7th to 23rd rnds incl:** Repeat
2nd rnd. **24th rnd:** Repeat 6th rnd.
25th rnd: Repeat 2nd rnd. **26th rnd:**
Sc in each sc, increasing 4 sc evenly
around. **27th to 37th rnds incl:** Repeat
2nd rnd. **38th rnd:** Sc in each sc,
decreasing 6 sc evenly around. **39th
rnd:** Sc in each sc, decreasing 7 sc
evenly around. Break off, leaving a 10-
inch length of thread. Thread through
remaining sts, pull up tightly and
fasten securely.

BONNET . . . Starting at center with
Robinette and No. 7 hook, ch 2. **1st
rnd:** 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. **2nd
rnd:** 2 sc in each sc around. **3rd rnd:**
* 2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc. Repeat
from * around. **4th and 5th rnds:**
Sc in each sc, increasing 6 sc evenly
around. Join in back loop of first sc.
6th rnd: Picking up back loop only,
sc in each sc around. **7th rnd:** Work-
ing through both loops, sc in each sc,
increasing 3 sc evenly around. **8th to
11th rnds incl:** Sc in each sc around.
12th rnd: Repeat 7th rnd. **13th rnd:**
Repeat 8th rnd.

BRIM . . . 1st row: Ch 1, 2 sc in
each sc across to within last 7 sc.
Ch 1, turn. **2nd to 10th rows incl:**
Skip first sc, sc in each sc across.
Ch 1, turn.

Work short rows as follows: **1st
to 6th rows incl:** Skip first sc, sc in
each sc across to within last 3 sc.
Ch 1, turn. Sc closely around edge of
Brim and back of Bonnet. Join and
break off.

HAIR . . . With double strand of
Brown and No. 4 hook, work as for
Head until 5 rnds have been completed.
Join and break off. With right side
facing, insert hook through any sc on
5th rnd to base of same sc, and, work-
ing over sc draw loop through, thread
over and draw loop through on hook,
draw loop on hook out to measure
1/2 inch (loop st made); retaining all
loops on hook, insert hook in next sc,
draw thread through, thread over and
draw through loop on hook, then draw
loop on hook out to measure same as
previous st. Make a loop st in each st
around. Break off. Work 2 more rnds
of loop sts in same manner. Break off.
Sew Hair to Head. Arrange first row
of loops to form bangs and tack in
place.

At end of 10th row, ch 10, turn; skip 9 sc, sl st in last sc. Now work in rnds as follows: **1st rnd:** Sc closely around 3 sides of Instep, sc in each ch of ch-10. **2nd to 5th rnds incl:** Sc in each sc around. Break off at end of 5th rnd. Sew across bottom. Stuff firmly with cotton. Sew to leg.

BELT . . . Starting at narrow end with Canary Yellow, ch 8. **1st row:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. Ch 1, turn. **2nd row:** Sc in each sc across. Ch 1, turn. Repeat 2nd row until Belt is slightly longer than Cowboy's waist. Break off. Embroider Belt with Black. Using Black double make a chain 1 inch long. Sew to Belt for buckle. Sew snap fastener to belt. Attach Blue to side of waist, ch 8, sl st at side for belt loop. Make a loop on other side.

FRINGE . . . Cut 4 strands of Canary Yellow 3 inches long, double these strands and draw through end sc at waist below belt, draw loose ends through loop and pull up tightly. Make a Fringe in every other row along one side. Trim ends evenly. Complete other side to correspond.

LARIAT . . . Cut 4 strands of Canary Yellow, each 36 inches long, twist these strands tightly, then double these strands and give them a twist in the opposite direction. Knot loose ends. Loop to form Lariat and sew to hand. Tie scarf around neck

MATERIALS:

J. & P. COATS "KNIT-CRO-SHEEN,"
Art. A.64: 2 balls each of No. 49-A
Killarney and No. 64 Platinum.

Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 0.

1 yard grey grosgrain ribbon, 1 inch wide.

Use thread double throughout.

GAUGE: 6 sc make 1 inch; 6 rnds make 1 inch.

Starting at center with Platinum, ch 2. **1st rnd:** 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Join. **2nd rnd:** 2 sc in each sc around. Join. **3rd rnd:** * Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc (1 sc increased). Repeat from * around. Join. **4th to 16th rnds incl:** Sc in each sc around, increasing 6 sc evenly on each rnd. Join. Work without increasing until piece measures 4½ inches. Break off. **Next rnd:** Attach Killarney and sc in back loop of each sc around. Join. Continue to work without increasing until piece measures 5½ inches in all.

BRIM . . . 1st rnd: Sc in each sc, increasing 10 sc evenly around. Join. **2nd rnd:** Sc in each sc around. Join. **3rd rnd:** Inc 10 sc evenly around. Join and break off. Mark joining for center back. **1st short row:** Attach Killarney to 20th st following center back, sc in same place, sc in each sc across to within 19 sc of center. Break off. **4th rnd:** Attach thread at center back and sc in each sc around. Join and break off. **2nd short row:** Attach thread to 26th sc from center back, sc in same place, sc in each sc around to within 25 sc on other side of center. Break off. **3rd short row:** Skip 5 sc on last short row, attach thread and sc in each sc to within last 5 sc. Break off. **5th rnd:** Attach thread at center back and sc in each sc around, increasing 10 sc evenly around. Join. **6th rnd:** Sc in each sc around. Join and break off. **4th short row:** Attach thread to 16th sc from center back, sc in each sc, increasing 8 sc evenly across to within last 16 sc, sl st in next sc. Break off. **5th short row:** Attach thread to 11th st from joining, sc in each sc around to within last 11 sc, sl st in next sc. Break off. **7th rnd:** Attach thread to center back

and sc in each sc around. Join. **8th rnd:** Inc 10 sc evenly around. Join.
9th rnd: Sc in each sc around. Join and break off.

UNDERBRIM . . . 1st rnd: Attach Platinum to center back and sc in back loop of each sc around, decreasing 10 sc evenly around—to *dec 1 sc, work off 2 sc as 1 sc*. Join. **2nd rnd:** Sc in each sc around. Join. **3rd rnd:** Dec 10 sc evenly around. Join. **4th to 7th rnds incl:** Repeat 2nd and 3rd rnds alternately 2 more times. Break off at end of 7th rnd. Sew Underbrim in place. Press hat. Tie ribbon around crown into a knot at side. Fringe ends of ribbon.

TOP HEEL PIECE . . . With double strand of Black, ch 9. Work as for Bottom Heel Piece.

Sew heel pieces together, catching only 1 loop on the edge of each piece. Cut a piece of cardboard slightly smaller than Bottom Sole. Sew joined heel pieces in place on Bottom Sole, having cardboard between. Sew Top Sole in place.

UPPER—Instep . . . Starting at toe end with single strand of Pink, ch 10. **1st row:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. Ch 1, turn. **2nd row:** 2 sc in first sc, sc in each sc across. Ch 1, turn.

Repeat 2nd row until there are on row	22 sts	24 sts	26 sts
Work without increasing until piece measures	4"	4"	4½"
Break off.			

Pin Instep in place on Sole.

BACK PIECE . . . With a single strand of Pink, make a chain to reach around back of sole, allowing $\frac{1}{2}$ inch overlap on each side. **1st row:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook; sc in each ch across. Ch 1, turn. **2nd row:** Sc in each sc across. Ch 1, turn. Repeat 2nd row until piece measures $1\frac{3}{4}$ inches. Break off. Sew back piece in place. Sew instep to sole, overlapping back piece on each side. Trim with sequins and beads as desired. Make other slipper the same way.
